

## CWO Reopening Community Safety Guidelines as of July 2020

- A **mask** covering your nose & mouth are required at all times in the building. (Workshops and Groups included.) *A disposable mask may be available upon request if needed.*
  - **Social Distancing** of 6 feet between people maintained at all times.
  - **Hand sanitizing/washing** upon entry.
  - Use **main MHA entrance and exit only**. *Medical necessity for direct CWO access with phone-in request from parking lot available (698-0671 or 329-8969 or 721-8663 or 478-2077)*
  - Screening questions will be asked when you enter.
- 

- CWO Main Space only, one scheduled workshop/group at a time. *No conference rooms available at present.*
- In-person workshops/groups will be a hybrid model, include simultaneous in-person and virtual members. All groups will continue to be accessible online.
- No food or drinks brought in and no food or drink available. Bringing a water bottle is okay.
- No free box items can be accepted at present. One personal bag can be kept under your seat/chair while you are at CWO.
- Individually sanitize your chair and table area before leaving.
- The CWO sinks will not be in use at this time.

- Leave your own art supplies at home. Pre-packaged art supplies will be available for use in workshops.
  - “Independent Art” is going to be on hold at this point. Open studio will have a select number of pre-packaged supplies available.
